2. Experience as our teacher.
3. Hope - Rom. 15:13 - He does not disappoint because He has poured out His love in our hearts by the Holy Spirit. Who was given to us.

### 1 Corinthians 13 -

1. What does the love of God look like, every believer has been filled with His love.
2. V-8 Love never fails.
3. Three things abide-faith, hope and love, the greatest is love 14 - pursue love.

### Application

#### Philippians 1:8 -

1. The practical application of His love operational in brother Paul.
2. The pursuit of the saints in unison with the love of Christ in Him. (Jn 3:16)
3. Prayer that their experience of the love of Christ in them would abound more and more in the knowledge and all discernment. Practical application.

#### Philippians 2:12

1. Work out your own salvation, for God is willing and doing for His good pleasure.
2. V-20 I have no one who has the same mind and affection for your state. (2 Cor. 5:14)
  - a. All seek their own, not the things which are of Jesus Christ.

1 John 3:14

1. We know we passed from death to life because we love the brethren, he who does not love abides in death. (John is talking to believers.)
2. What does love look like - He laid down His life for us, we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
3. Love that is in action.
4. His commandment to us - believe and love.

1 John 4:7 -

1. Be loving one another for this love is of God, He who loves is born of God and knows God.
2. God is love. Are we in the experience of knowing Him and loving? Can't know Him and not love.
3. We love Him because He first loved us.
