DELAYED BY SATANIC INTERVENTION

Daniel 10:1-3, 11-14 "In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message was true, but the appointed time was long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision. In those days I, **Daniel, was mourning three full weeks.** I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, **till three whole weeks were fulfilled.** (11-14) And he said to me, 'O Daniel, man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I now have been sent to you.' While he was speaking this word came to me, I stood trembling. Then he said to me, 'Do not fear, Daniel, for **from the first day that you set your heart to understand,** and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words. **But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days**; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia. Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to many days yet to come."

God's Solution For Satanic Intervention

<u>Matthew 17:14-21</u> "And when they had come to the multitude, a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying, 'Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water. <u>So I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him.</u>' Then Jesus answered and said, 'O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me.' And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, <u>'Why could we not cast it out?'</u> So Jesus said to them, <u>'Because of your unbelief:</u> for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. <u>However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.'"</u>

<u>2</u> Corinthians 10:3-6 "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled."

Hebrews 5:7-9 "...who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience (proved the meaning of obedience) by the things which He suffered. And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,..."

<u>2 Corinthians 2:9-11</u> "For to this end I also wrote, that I might put you to the test, <u>whether you</u> <u>are obedient in all things</u>. Now whom you forgive anything, <u>I also forgive</u>. For if indeed I have forgiven anything, I have forgiven that one for your sakes in the presence of Christ, lest Satan should take advantage of us; <u>for we are not ignorant of his devices.</u>"

Ephesians 6:10-18 "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; **praying always with all prayer and supplication for all the saints—...**"

The Greatest Result of the Resurrection

Colossians 1:27-28 "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is **Christ in you the hope of glory**. Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus."

Romans 4:25 " ... who was delivered up because of our offenses, and raised because of our justification."

Romans 10:9 "... that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

Two Judgements

Hebrews 9:27 "And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this is judgement,.."

Judgement for the Believer

Romans 14:10-13 "But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you show contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgement seat of Christ. For it is written: 'As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow, every tongue shall confess to God.' So then each of us shall give account of himself to God. **Therefore let us not judge one another any more,** but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way."

<u>2 Corinthians 5:9-11</u> "Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. For we must all appear before the judgement seat of Christ, that <u>each one</u> may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad. Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences."

Judgement of the Unbeliever

Revelation 20:11-15 "Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire."

Philippians 2:12-14 "Therefore my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure."
