- Gen. 1:26 **Let us make man in our image.**
- A. Let them have dominion.
 - B. Over everything created.
 - C. Over all the earth.
- Gen. 2:16 **The command for man from the Lord=Don't eat of that tree.**
- A. For in the day you eat of it you will die.
 - B. The tree of life was everything and more than the one forbidden.
 - C. Satan was in the forbidden, drawing man from God. (Compromise.)
- Gen. 3- **Adam and Eve's disobedience changed the entire human race.**
- A. Eve fell in 5 verses-started interacting with Satan.
 - B. Second voice alternative outcome.
 - C. Their eyes were opened to see their nakedness apart from God.
 - D. Sin caused them to step out on their own.
 - E. We are incomplete without Him, we were created to be one with Him.
- Gen. 4 **Cains offering rejected (a bloodless offering).**
- A. If you do well as I have spoken to you, you will be accepted. It's His way or no way.
 - B. If you choose not to obey, sins desire will overtake-you.
 - C. You can rule over it by heeding what I have spoken.
 - D. Next verse He killed his brother. Stepped out from under the Lord's speaking.
- Gen. 6 **Man on his own outside the keeping of God's word.**
- A. The Lords heart was grieved at the condition man fallen to. Man's independent free will had let to this condition.
 - B. Disobedience had matured to the point man couldn't think of anything but evil.
- Deut 8. **The Lord introduced an entirely new way of living.**
- A. He might make you know that man does not live by bread alone.
 - B. Man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

2 Cor. 10:4

Warfare

- A. Mighty in God.
- B. For pulling down strongholds, casting down high things that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. (Our reasoning.)
- C. Capturing it to the obedience of Christ.
- D. Punishing all disobedience when obedience is fulfilled.
