- 2. I beseech (or beg) you to present your bodies.
- 3. A living sacrifice.
- 4. Holy, acceptable to God.
- 5. This is your reasonable service. (Or rational.)

Romans 12:2 Outside pressure to be something of this age.

- 1. Do not be conformed, or fashioned by, and to, this age.
 - a. The subject must consent to this age to be fashioned by it.
 - **b**. The internal working of the Holy Spirit.
 - c. But be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Matthew 17:2, 2 Corinthians 3:18

2. Purpose-that you may prove by use what is that good and acceptable perfect will of God. (Christ likeness.)

Phil. 2:12- The working out of what is within. (Col. 1:27)

- 1. Work out your own salvation.
- 2. With fear and trembling.
- 3. Vs.13 For it is God who is working in you.
- 4. Both to will and do for His good pleasure.

Heb. 13:20- Working what is pleasing to Him.

- 1. May He make you complete in every good work. (To do His will.)
- 2. Working in you what is well pleasing in His sight.

3. Through Jesus Christ.

Col. 1:9 Expressing and growing in the expression of His will.

- 1. Filled with the knowledge of His will.
- 2. The outworking of the in working Christ.

2 Cor. 4:10-11 The dealing with our will that His will is expressed. (Romans 8:13)

- 1. Always the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus.
- 2. Manifested in our mortal bodies. What a work the life of Christ expressed in our bodies.
