 - a. From which we are waiting for our savior the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - b. Promise = who will transform our lowly body to be like His glorious body by the power that enables Him to subject all things to Himself.

Colossians 3:1

- 1. If you have been raised with Christ (Eph. 2:6).
 - a. Seek the things above where Christ is.
 - b. Set your minds on the things above-not on things of earth.

Colossians 3:3
