- Acts 2:1-4 "When the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

## **Speaking in tongues as in prayer to God.**

- <u>1 Corinthians 14:2</u> "For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:4</u> "He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church."
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:14</u> "For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful."
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:15</u> "What is the conclusion then? I will pray with the spirit, and will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding."
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:18-19</u> "I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all; yet in the church I would rather speak five words with my understanding, that I may teach others also, than ten thousand words in a tongue."
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:37-40</u> "If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord. But if anyone is ignorant, let him be ignorant. Therefore, brethren, desire

earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues. Let all things be done decently and in order."

<u>Jude 20-21</u> "But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And on some have compassion, making a distinction; but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh."
