Ephesians 2:1-

- 1. Condition of the human race.
 - a. Dead in trespasses and sins.
 - b. Held captive by Satan. 1 John 5:19
 - c. Living out the lusts of our flesh
 - d. Positioned for the wrath of God. (Satan's desire is to occupy us in the fallen flesh until we run out of time.)

Ephesians 2:4

- 1. Divine intervention (but God). The language describes a change of direction.
 - a. But God rich in mercy.
 - b. Because of His great love with which He loved (loves) us.

Made us alive together.

Position. Colossians 3

Ephesians 2:6

- 1. Raised us up together.
- 2. Made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:1

- 1. If then you were raised with Christ.
- 2. Seek those things which are above not of this world.
- 3. Set your mind emphasizes an ongoing habitual decision on things above not on things of the earth.
- 4. Things are obstacles my flesh lusts for. (Galatians 5:16).
- 5. You died. Galatians 2:20, 6:14
- 6. Your life is hidden with Christ in God. = The Greek word for hidden indicates that God has accomplished this in the past so that now it is a present reality.
- 7. Ephesians 1:4. He chose us in himself before the foundation of the

world.

Colossians 3:4

1. When Christ our life appears then you will also appear with Him in glory.

Colossians 3:5

- 1. Therefore because of everything above put to death your members which are on earth. Activities of fallen human flesh.
