#### **The Power of the Cross**

Dealt with sin, dealt with us and deals with us.

### **Matthew 16:21-**

- 1. From that time on He began to show His disciples.
  - a. He must go to Jerusalem.
  - b. He must suffer many things.
  - c. From the religious establishment.
  - d. He would be killed and raised on the third day.

# Matthew 16:22 This proclamation of the Lord's purpose did not fit Peter's mindset.

- 1. Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him.
- 2. Far be it from You Lord, this shall not happen to You.
- 3. Satan came in on Peter's unwillingness to submit to the Lord speaking.
- 4. You are mindful of the things of man but not the things of God.

#### **Matthew 16:24**

- 1. If anyone desires = has strong feelings about following Me.
- 2. Let him deny = with strong denial or rejection of himself/herself.
- 3. Take us his cross and follow Me.

## **Matthew 16:25**

- 1. Whoever desires, has strong intentions of saving his life, will lose it.
- 2. Whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.
- 3. Vs. 26 what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world and loses his soul?

## **Galatians 6:12** - Religious persecution.

1. Desire to make a good showing in the flesh.

- 2. A strong desire for compliance by association.
- 3. But God forbid I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.
  - a. By which the world and everything in it has been crucified to me.
  - b. And I to the world. (Past tense with Gal. 2:20.) Present tense in Gal. 5:16-
  - c. The fruit of the Spirit (Love) = and it's expression.
  - d. Vs. 24 and those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with it's passions and desires.
  - e. If we live in the Spirit let us also walk in the Spirit.
