Bound in trespasses and sin accentuated by the law.
a. The law has dominion over us as long as we live.

<u>Romans 7:2</u>

- 1. Bound to her husband as long as he lives.
- 2. But if the husband dies,
- 3. She is released from the law of that husband.

Romans 7:4 -

1. Therefore, my brethren you have become dead to the law through the body of Christ. (Heb. 10-).

- 2. That you may be married to another to Him.
- 3. Who was raised from the dead.
- 4. That you should bear fruit to God. Him as our supply Gal. 5:22.

Romans 7:5

1. When we were married to another in the flesh the sinful passions which were aroused by law,

2. Were working in our members to bear fruit to death.

Romans 7:6

1. But now we have been delivered from the law having died to what we were held by.

2. Why? So that we should serve in newness of the Spirit not the oldness of the letter.
