SPIRITUAL PEOPLE?

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:23</u>

"Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

NOTE: In speaking of creation in **Zech. 12:1** "Thus says the Lord who stretches out the heavens, lays the foundation of the earth, and forms **the spirit of man within him.**" He mentions **the spirit of man in first importance** in the parts of man.

<u>NOTE</u>: Any spiritual work first begins with the Spirit of God and our human spirit.

<u>John 4:24</u>

"God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

<u>Romans 1:9</u>

"For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of His Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers,"

NOTE: Our human spirit takes preference in our leadership even over "a door opened by the Lord."

<u>2 Corinthians 2:12-13</u>

"Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened to me by the Lord, I had no rest in my spirit, because I did not find Titus my brother; but taking my leave of them, I departed for Macedonia."

1 Corinthians 3:1-9

"And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not carnal?

Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor.

For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building."

Reward and Loss

<u>1 Corinthians 3:10-16</u>

"According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"
