

Choices

Genesis 2:16

1. The Lord commanded the man.
 - a. You can eat of every tree in the garden.
 - b. But of the tree **of the knowledge of** good and evil, you shall not eat.
 - c. **For the day** that you eat it, in dying you will die.

Genesis 3-

1. Which tree was the serpent wanting to choose for man?
2. The promise was self-enrichment.
3. Man chose himself over the Lord. (James 3:16)
4. Did they get what was promised?
5. Genesis 6:5 - every intent of the thoughts of mans heart was evil **all the day**.

Deuteronomy 28-

1. It shall come to pass if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God.
 - a. To observe (attentive watch) carefully all His commandments that I command you **today**. The Lord will set you on high.
 - b. All these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you.
 - i. Because you obey the voice of the Lord your God.

Deuteronomy 28:15-

1. It shall come to pass if you don't obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you **today**, that all these curses will come upon you.

Deuteronomy 30-

1. If you return to the Lord your God and obey His voice. (Two voices.)
2. V5-10

3. But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart that you may do it.
4. Two choices set before us. Life and good, death and evil.
5. I command you **today** to love the Lord your God, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments.
6. V-19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses **today** against you, set before us life and death, blessing and cursing. Therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live.
7. V-20 That you may love the Lord your God.
 - a. That you may obey His voice.
 - b. That you may cling to Him.
 - c. For He is your life and the length of your days. (Col. 3:4)
