## **Genesis 2:16**

- 1. The Lord commanded the man.
  - a. You can eat of every tree in the garden.
  - b. But of the tree **of the knowledge of** good and evil, you shall not eat.
  - c. For the day that you eat it, in dying you will die.

## Genesis 3-

- 1. Which tree was the serpent wanting to choose for man?
- 2. The promise was self-enrichment.
- 3. Man chose himself over the Lord. (James 3:16)
- 4. Did they get what was promised?
- 5. Genesis 6:5 every intent of the thoughts of mans heart was evil **all the day**.

## **Deuteronomy 28-**

- 1. It shall come to pass if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God.
  - a. To observe (attentive watch) carefully all His commandments that I command you **today**. The Lord will set you on high.
  - b. All these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you.
    - i. Because you obey the voice of the Lord your God.

## **Deuteronomy 28:15**-

1. It shall come to pass if you don't obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you **today**, that all these curses will come upon you.

# **Deuteronomy 30-**

- 1. If you return to the Lord your God and obey His voice. (Two voices.)
- 2. V5-10

- 3. But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart that you may do it.
- 4. Two choices set before us. Life and good, death and evil.
- 5. I command you **today** to love the Lord your God, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments.
- 6. V-19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses **today** against you, set before us life and death, blessing and cursing. Therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live.
- 7. V-20 That you may love the Lord your God.
  - a. That you may obey His voice.
  - b. That you may cling to Him.
  - c. For He is your life and the length of your days. (Col. 3:4)
