Partaking of the Mystery of God

Ephesians 3:1

- 1. Paul a prisoner of Jesus Christ. (Physical and Spiritual.)
- 2. Grace = the revelation of the mystery.
- 3. The Holy Spirit revealing to the apostles and prophets.
- 4. That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ Jesus. Through the gospel (Rom. 1:16).
- 5. Paul became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God, given to me
 - a. by the effective working of His power.

The Expression of this Mystery

Ephesians 3:8-13

- 1. Grace came that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ.
- 2. To make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery
 - a. from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Christ.
 - b. To the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to principalities and powers in heavenly places.
 - c. God's eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord
 - i. in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

The Heart of the Mystery

<u>Ephesians 3:14-21</u>

- 1. The Family, our family, that He would grant you according to the riches of His glory to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,
- 2. that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with the new family, what is the width and length and depth and height—
- 3. to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
- 4. Now to Him who is able.
