Enoch

Genesis 5:22, 23

1. After the birth of Methuselah, Enoch walked with God.
 - a. He walked with God and was not, God took him.
 - b. Heb. 11:5 Before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Noah

Genesis 6:9,22. 7:5

1. Noah walked with God
 - a. Gen. 6:22 Noah did according to all that God commanded him, so he did.
 - b. Gen. 7:5 Noah did according to all that the Lord commanded him.
 - c. Heb. 11:7 By faith Noah being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with Godly fear, prepared an ark and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

Abraham

Genesis 17:1

1. Abraham was ninety five years old, the Lord appeared and said, “Walk before Me and be blameless.”
 - a. Heb 11:8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out.

Moses

Numbers 20:8

1. Speak to the rock.

Deuteronomy 8:3

1. He led His people into an impossible situation in the wilderness to cause them to know that man shall not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.
2. The possibility of a new kind of living. (Faith)
