In Order for Grace

1 Peter 5:5-11

<u>1 Peter 5:5</u>

- 1. Younger people submit yourselves to your elders.
- 2. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another.
- 3. Be clothed with humility.
 - a. God resists (sets Himself as a military line against) the proud.
 - b. But He gives grace to the humble.

<u>1 Peter 5:6</u>

- 1. Therefore, humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God
- 2. That <u>He may</u> exalt you in due time.

<u>1 Peter 5:7</u>

- 1. Casting (moving the responsibility to another) your care upon Him.
- 2. For He cares for you.

<u>Why</u>

<u>1 Peter 5:8</u>

- 1. Be sober, (self-controlled) be vigilant (watchful).
- 2. Because your adversary the Devil walks about like a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour.

<u>1 Peter 5:9</u>

- 1. Resist him (avoid taking yourself), take a stand steadfast in the faith
 - a. Knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in this world.

<u>1 Peter 5:10</u>

- 1. But may the God of all grace who called you to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus after you have suffered a while
- 2. Perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

<u>1 Peter 5:11</u>

1. To Him be the glory and dominion forever and ever amen.
